

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING  
OF THE BRAHAM CITY COUNCIL  
For Adoption of a Body-Worn Camera Policy  
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 12, 2018  
7:15 P.M.

The Public Hearing was called to order with the following present: Mayor Patricia Carlson; Council Members Lowell Jaques and Jeremy Kunshier; City Administrator Sally Hoy; and Police Chief Eric Baumgart. Council Members Shawn Sullivan and Vicky Ethen were absent.

Delwayne Hahn was present from the Isanti County News and Scott McKinney was present from the Braham Journal. No one was present in the audience for the Public Hearing purpose.

This was the 3<sup>rd</sup> and last required public meeting to implement the use of Body-Worn Cameras by the Braham Police Department. This meeting covered the proposed adoption of a Body-Worn Camera Policy. Taken off the model policy from the League of MN Cities, it was tailored for the Braham Police Department and reviewed by the City Attorney.

Police Chief Eric Baumgart presented an overview of the Body-Worn Camera Policy to the council. He reported that the Lexipol Policy mirrors the Body-Worn Camera Policy, and any changes are implemented in the Lexipol Policy. He noted that he would be doing monthly audits of the data.

Council Member Lowell Jaques asked if the changes in the system are made in writing, and Baumgart explained that the original policy remains in the system, and changes to the policy are dated and stamped that it had been amended. Baumgart said the Body-Worn Camera Policy will be posted on the City's website, as required by State Statute, and people could also call for a copy of the policy.

Mayor Carlson asked for any other questions. Hearing none, Carlson moved, and Jaques seconded to adjourn the public hearing. Motion carried 3-0. The hearing adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
