AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SHOOTING OF FIREARMS  
WITHIN THE CITY OF BRAHAM


The City Council of the City of Braham, Minnesota hereby ordains:



No person shall discharge any type of firearm, bow and arrow, crossbow, slingshot, boomerang, or any other type of propelled device within the corporate limits of the City of Braham without first obtaining written permission from the Braham Police Department except:

- a.) Persons duly authorized to act as law enforcement officers or members of the military forces of the United States or the State of Minnesota in the performance of their duties.
- b.) Duly authorized persons engaged in the U.S. military and/or veteran's organizations may fire blank honor salutes over the graves of military personnel, or in designated memorial areas.
- c.) Archery is authorized within businesses with indoor shooting facilities.

Any person and/or business entity violating the provision of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$1000.00 or imprisoned for a period of not to exceed 90 days or both.
